

Ball Grove Volunteer Day

On Saturday 8th June, a vast amount of work was carried out by volunteers at Ball Grove. This was jointly organised by Pendle Borough Council and the Friends of Ball Grove group. Please see below the list of tasks completed.

A number of the volunteers attended from the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter Day Saints, which is the church Mel Henley attends.

On Saturday 30 people joined in, we even had a creche for babies so parents could contribute.

We completed the following:

The Friends bed was weeded and barked

The back by LBS was barked

Signs were all cleaned

The area full of brambles, nettles and dead beaches by the hedge running along the track was cleared.

The steps were built

About half of the wild primroses were planted.

A total of around 40 volunteer hours!

The rubbish has been left by the Friends bed and by the side of the track where the hedge starts.

The bark unfortunately was very low quality being more than 50 % leaves and so will in effect compost down.

This will mean that it will need to be replaced in the steps at some point.

Also there is loads left as the tree surgeon was very generous with it.

He put it right in the middle of where I park (I did ask him to put it to the side, but perhaps he misunderstood.

I can shift it to the side, but given its poor quality it needs to be taken away please.
